



The Alliance Française de la Nouvelle Orleans is seeking part-time French language instructors, for group and private classes.

Requirements:

- Experience teaching adults and/or children (experience with both is a plus)
- A degree in French as a Foreign Language (Master FLE, DAEFLE or equivalent), or a degree in Education.
- Legal permission to work in the U.S.: Visa, Citizenship, or Permanent Resident status
- Flexibility in scheduling: we offer daytime, evening, and Saturday daytime group classes, and private classes. We ask that you be available for at least two of these time slots, though it will not always be necessary. Classes run in either 5-week or 10-week sessions.
  - Weekday group classes are once or twice a week, Mon-Thurs, sometime between the hours of 10am-3pm, and 5-8:30pm.
  - Saturday group classes are 1.5 – 3 hours in duration, between 9am and 1:30pm.
  - Private classes are generally weekdays or evenings, Mon-Thurs.
- A dynamic, creative, but dependable work ethic. We need to be sure that you'll be regularly available for classes and that you'll arrive on time and complete the class, sticking to the schedule as given.
- Native French-speaking preferred, but not necessary.

We offer:

- A flexible work environment with regard to your schedule, different levels of students, and various settings (private/group/off-site).
- Teacher training sessions, including training to administer the internationally recognized French proficiency DELF exams. Last years' workshops included teaching with TV5 (French News Program), with music, and with graphic novels.
- The chance to work with a non-profit organization with a long and dedicated history of championing French and Francophone language and culture, in the most French city in the U.S. The Alliance Française was founded in 1883, and has over 800 chapters in 135 countries.
- Pay rates between \$24 and \$33 per hour, depending on your experience, education, and the class type.
